Re: Proposed Brandt Wastewater Treatment Plant, Miami County

Dear Ladies/Sirs:

The area of Brandt in Miami County is located within the Facilities Plan service area of Clark County's Southwest Regional WWTP. The Southwest Regional WWTP was built in 1979 with the benefit of a USEPA construction grant. In 2006, an interceptor extension was completed along Mud Creek north of Park Layne, terminating at US Route 40, just east of SR 235. This interceptor extension was funded from local debt.

Representatives from Miami County Sanitary Engineering Department met with us last fall to inform us that no appreciable development would take place in Bethel Township (Miami County) in the foreseeable future, and that they would not need to discharge wastewater to the Southwest Regional WWTP. They indicated they were planning a quasi-onsite treatment system for the Brandt area.

The proposed Brandt WWTP has a design capacity of 45,000 gpd. What service area is defined for this WWTP?

What alternatives and corresponding cost analyses were included in the Antidegradation review?

What is the treatment technology and what is the expected effluent quality from the proposed Brandt WWTP?
